Fire	<p>Naked flame use in tents.</p> <p>Poorly maintained electrical equipment.</p>	<p>Briefing on arrival</p> <p>Fire extinguishers and suitable equipment will be provided.</p> <p>Bell system in place.</p> <p>Appropriate signage.</p>
Personal Injury & Illness	<p>Use of outdoor elements</p> <p>Trip hazards</p> <p>Ticks</p>	<p>Signage and protocol to prevent mis-use of outdoor equipment.</p> <p>On-going management by camp leader to ensure hazards are removed or minimised.</p>
Hygiene	<p>Poor level of guest hygiene</p> <p>Dirty facilities</p> <p>Contaminated water</p> <p>Catering</p>	<p>Briefing on arrival.</p> <p>Regular inspection and cleaning of facilities.</p> <p>Hand washing.</p> <p>Water sampling.</p> <p>See Crab Apple for Catering.</p>
Security	<p>General public entering site</p> <p>Students walking off-site</p>	<p>The campsite is private (the general public are not permitted)</p> <p>Staff to question people who are not recognised.</p> <p>The area is fenced and gated.</p> <p>Land & Wave staff will be present overnight.</p> <p>Appropriate signage and briefing</p> <p>Groups allocated specific area.</p>
